This is our classic spec for the Hoxton widebeam, but you can customise your space to make it entirely your own. Please speak to a member of our team for more details.


BATHROOM

- 800mm x 800mm quadrant shower tray set in black framed shower enclosure
- Underfloor heating with a choice of floor tiles
- Single basin mounted on quartz slab vanity units
- Stand-alone roll top bath
- Large illuminated mirror set between two wall lights
- Designer taps and shower mixers throughout
- Wall mounted heated towel rail

THE LIVING AREA

- Generous central skylight allows light to pour in
- Choice of attractive solid fuel (or diesel option) cast iron stove set in designer feature tiles
- 32" wall-mounted TV
- Ample room to accommodate a sofa, chair, coffee table and/or dining table
- Sustainable reclaimed wood wall panelling with contrasting off white ceiling and grey below gunwale walls

THE MASTER BEDROOM

- 'Wrap-around' bow to maximise space
- King-size bed with ample storage

THE WALKTHROUGH

THE STERN

Step aboard and you'll find yourself on the thoughtfully designed stern, an outside space that's perfect for relaxing and socialising, whether you're moored up or cruising. It features wraparound seating, with weather-resistant, removable cushions and space for a free-standing dining table. Four deck lights create a warm, welcoming atmosphere as the sun settles for the evening.

It's an attractive, practical space, with integrated storage compartments and a lockable cabinet alongside the steering position. The deck itself is fitted with Tek-Dek – a UV-stabilised, stain-resistant synthetic teak flooring with superb non-slip qualities that's usually fitted on luxury yachts. Finally, the whole stern area has an option for a retractable tonneau cover, providing shelter from the sun or rain, and making this a space to enjoy, all year round.

THE LIVING AREA

You'll enter the boat's beautiful living area via three centrally positioned steps. Crafted with the same quality Tek-Dek flooring, they also double as discreet integrated storage space. The contemporary open living area boasts a totally original design and styling using Scandinavian influences to create an industrial feel. It features attractive full height storage and shelving units and a two door base unit which also houses a 32" wall hung TV.

Contemporary, wall-mounted radiators and an attractive solid fuel stove creates immediate warmth and a welcoming, cosy feel. We've added a wall-mounted 32" flat-screen TV and there's plenty of room to add your own handpicked freestanding furniture, creating a space that's all your own.

THE KITCHEN

Alongside the living area, in the same open-plan space, you'll find your modern kitchen that's been beautifully designed to maximise space and offer a luxurious, high-spec finish.

Against the back wall, soft grey oak cabinets sit above a feature herringbone tiled wall. Below, the contemporary push-close kitchen cabinets and kick boards contrast beautifully with the limed oak wood-effect flooring.

There's a built-in oven and four-burner hob, complete with extractor fan, and the underslung sink and draining board are neatly set into the smooth surface. We've added all the modern appliances you'd expect – including an integrated washing machine, fridge and freezer – and some you might not, like a sleek, slimline wine cooler.

The granite work surfaces offer plenty of prep area and the hardwood breakfast bar, with stylish pendant lights above, can comfortably seat three people. From preparing simple snacks to exquisite fine dining, we've designed the perfect space that can easily cope with both and everything in between.

THE BATHROOM

Like the kitchen, the spacious bathroom is finished to the same high-spec as you'd expect in a premium apartment. It easily accommodates not only a full-sized roll top bath, but a separate corner shower and wash basin, finished with stylish black taps. There's a feature mirror above the basin illuminated by subtle lighting and recessed spotlights in the ceiling.

We've added a sleek heated towel rail and, for a touch of boutique hotel luxury, we've set underfloor heating beneath beautiful black and white porcelain tiles.

THE MASTER BEDROOM

The luxurious master bedroom sits at the front of the boat in the spacious bow area and boasts a wonderful 76cm-wide window to allow plenty of light and air.

At the heart of the room is a generous king-size bed with plenty of storage space underneath. There's also a wall-mounted TV for relaxed night time viewing. Access to the dressing area is via a stable style design door hung from black ironmongery. The dressing area contains a generous amount of hanging space and pull-out racking to easily store everything you need.
